Grape variety	100% Cabernet Sauvignon
Region	Barossa Valley
The Wine	The grapes for this special 2018 Cabernet were harvested in the cool, early hours of the morning to beat the heat. They were then de-stemmed and crushed into small, open-top fermenters.
The growers	RedHeads favourite growers supplied the top-notch fruit that was then hand-selected by our winemakers.
Ageing	The wine is being aged in a mix of both French and American oak. It will have rested for 21 months in barrel.
Tasting notes	In the glass, look forward to layer upon layer of ripe black currant and blackberry, with accents of toasty vanilla and spice, silky tannins and a seriously long, smooth finish.
