WE HUNT THE BEST GROWERS AND PRIZE THE FINEST FRUIT FROM THEIR TOP VINEYARDS, THEN WE ADD A TOUCH OF OUR WINEMAKING MAGIC TO CRAFT THIS SHIRAZ WITH EVERYTHING YOU HAVE COME TO EXPECT FROM A REDHEADS RED. RICH, BOLD, INTENSE. IT'S AN AUSSIE CLASSIC.



- Grape Variety:** 100% Shiraz
- Region:** Marananga region of Barossa Valley
- Vintage:** The '21 vintage was a cracker for shiraz. A cool, wet start to the growing season which set the vintage up nicely. Over late Spring and Summer, conditions dried out allowing for ultimate fruit ripeness.
- The Growers:** From Darren Zimmerman's vineyard next door to renowned wine producer, Torbreck's Shiraz vineyard!
- Winemaking:** Fruit was brought into the Redheads winery, gently crushed, fermented in open top fermenters, 14 days on skins. Secondary fermentation was in a combination of French and American oak for 18 months. Finally, bottled locally using locally made bottles and caps.
- Tasting Notes:** Distinctly Barossa Shiraz with deep, dark berry and blackcurrant notes, pepper and spice and hints of cassis. Well balanced with structural tannins showing why Shiraz is truly the king varietal in the Barossa.
- Food Pairing:** A hearty steak!
